1.0 Call to Order & Pledge Allegiance to the Flag: The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by 2nd District Representative Lewis Murray. Lewis introduced Supervisor Dawn Rowe as a special guest. Supervisor Rowe welcomed everyone and gave a brief overview of her office and the transition of the Rim of the World Communities and the Crest Forest MAC to the 3rd District.

2.0 Swearing in of MAC members: Murray swore in James Grant, Michelle Ambrozic, Ken Stowe, and Jenny Hueter to the Lake Arrowhead MAC

2.0 Special Guests:

- a. Jennifer Cusack, Southern California Edison: Jennifer discussed the past several years of vegetation management performed by SCE. She also discussed outages, both planned and unplanned. She discussed the recent outages that occurred during the New Year's holiday and some of the reasons behind the outages. She answered questions from the attendees.

- b. **Sandra Cuellar, Spectrum:** Sandra stated that broadband service is dependent on electrical power. They currently have 4-hour battery back-up system, but are working to have a new 72-hour system in place by late summer.

3.0 Community & Agency Updates:

- **San Bernardino County Sheriff, Lt. Craig Harris** mentioned that **Coffee with a Cop** scheduled for March 11th has been postponed. He discussed snow play / parking stats. There was a recent double homicide in Twin Peaks. Suspect is in custody. There was a vehicle to vehicle shooting. 2 arrested. Station is fully staffed except for one Sgt. opening.
- **California Highway Patrol, Office Grieda:** discussed several incidents on Hwy 18. Also discussed staffing at the Running Springs Station.
- **SB County Fire, Mark Bixler** shared that they will be updating the Mountain Area Safety Taskforce (MAST) in the near future. Working with Laura Dyberg and Mountain Rim Fire Safe Council to coordinate chipping.
- **Cal Fire, BC Brett Taylor** introduced new Battalion Chief Jason Mahan. Mahan discussed a thinning project at Upper Little Bear HOA They have been busy with out of area fires. They are planning several pile burning projects. Construction is underway at Pilot Rock Camp.
- **LACSD: Catherine Cerri** asked for input from the community regarding LACSD taking over the administration of AWAC. They are rescheduling the meet and greet with Senator Ochoa Bogh and Assemblyman Smith. They are keeping an eye on the lake level as it relates to possible conservation.
- **Lake Arrowhead Communities Chamber of Commerce: Robin Bull** that they have joined forces with San Bernardino County Housing Authority. They participated in a County sponsored Job Fair. Next mixer is March 9th at the Lake Arrowhead Resort. She also discussed the Brewfest and the Home Tour.
- **ALA, Bob Mattison** discussed lake level, the recent election, and the start of 2022 membership renewals.
- **Rim of the World Recreation and Park District: Jenny Hueter** shared that finding a park location in the Crestline area is a high priority. They hired an athletic director for the District. She also discussed upcoming events and activities.

- **A Better Place, Forest:** Susan Melcher introduced herself, and shared information on their memorial park located in Twin Peaks.
- **Senator Ochoa Bogh:** Sidney Sonck discussed proposed legislation. Their legislative team is working on fact sheets.

4.0 Supervisor's Report: Lewis Murray shared that the Board of Supervisors approved all MAC appointments at their meeting this morning. There is currently a vacancy on the Lake Arrowhead MAC. Murray discussed recent grants awarded to nonprofits in the Rim of the World area.
