



## **Crest Forest Municipal Advisory Council MEETING MINUTES**

**Tuesday, July 12, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.**

- 1.0 Call to Order & Pledge Allegiance to the Flag: The meeting was called to order at 6:33 pm by Chair Steve Garcia**
- 2.0 Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Kyle Schulty and seconded by Rick Dinon to approve the minutes of the June 7, 2022 meeting. Approved 5/0/0**
- 3.0 Special Guest: San Bernardino County Code Enforcement Chief Ignacio Nunez gave a presentation related to Short Term Rentals (STRs). He discussed changes to the existing ordinance that were adopted by the Board of Supervisors on June 14<sup>th</sup>. Specifically, he discussed changes to occupancy levels, noise monitoring, transfer of permits, neighbor notification, enforcement, fees and penalties, expanded hours for Code Enforcement staff, and several other topics. He also invited people to view the STR website, which has a map of existing STRs, recent stats and enforcement actions, and links for applying for a permit. He then answered questions from the audience.**
- 4.0 Lake Gregory Community Advisory Committee Report: Bill Mellinger discussed dredging, maintaining silt basins, completion of new trail, the meadow, dog park, and the installing of docks. The Bait and Tackle should be in next week. They are still working on the Zip Line and e-bikes. Nathan Godwin shared that they are working on plans for Camp Switzerland, applying for grants for the playground, plans for the pavilion, weed abatement issues near the senior center, and parking/traffic issues. Attendance started out slow in June but is going very well at this point in time. Nathan also mention stocking of trout, Jamboree Days, and the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks.**
- 5.0 Community & Governmental Agency Updates:**
  - **San Bernardino County Sheriff: Cpt. Lupear shared that Jamboree Days went very smoothly with few**

calls for service. All in all, the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend went well. They continue to do OHV patrols. Other topics discussed included homelessness, lake patrols, and a new officer arriving in early August. He also invited everyone to the "Pizza & Patrol" event tomorrow from 2 to 5 pm at the Lake Arrowhead Deli.

- **CHP: Lt. Napoleon Salais:** Lt. Salais introduced himself. He is getting acquainted with the area. He discussed 5 vacancies at the Arrowhead office and efforts statewide to recruit new officers.
- **Mountain Transit:** Kyle Schultzy announced that Mountain Transit has a board vacancy and they are accepting applications.
- **USFS:** Brian Grant discussed staffing levels, the recent Frog Fire and the Pine Fire in Devil's Canyon. Things were quiet in the national forest over the 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend.
- **Senator Ochoa Bogh:** Sidney Sonck discussed the LACSD/AWAC bill SB 1405. It would create the first steps towards combining the two agencies. They have received some negative comments. The Senator plans on holding more meetings and meeting with members of the public.

**6.0 Supervisor's Report:** Lewis Murray shared that he will be joining Supervisor Rowe's team after Supervisor Rutherford's term ends on January 2, 2023. He recently met with Supervisor Rowe and gave her a driving tour of the Rim of the World area. He also discussed the Short-Term Rental (STR) Moratorium, and the possibility of caps on STRs. He then presented a County Resolution to Steve Garcia for receiving the Crestline Citizen of the Year recognition.
