



Crest Forest Municipal Advisory Council MEETING MINUTES

Tuesday, August 2, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

1.0 Call to Order & Pledge Allegiance to the Flag: The meeting was called to order at 6:32 pm by Chair Steve Garcia

2.0 Approval of Minutes: A motion was made by Gil Flores and seconded by Penny Shubnell to approve the minutes of the July 12, 2022 meeting. Approved 5/0/0

3.0 Special Guest: Andrea Harlin, Government & Legislative Affairs Liaison, California Department of Transportation – District 8: Andrea gave an update on several projects. They included a culvert repair project on Hwy 18 between 40th Street and Hwy 138. Start date to be determined. The Red Rock Wall project is moving forward with an anticipated re-opening date of early September. She also discussed the issue of big rigs and busses on the Hwy 189 detour. She answered questions from the audience.

4.0 Lake Gregory Community Advisory Committee Report: The LGCAC did not meet last month. Several topics were discussed including parking issues, noise from the park impacting the community, ebikes, bait and tackle shop, the proposed playground, and Camp Switzerland.

5.0 Community & Governmental Agency Updates:

- **County Fire: Bryan James said he did not have much to report. Things have been slow on the mountain. He reminded everyone of the Residential Assessment Program (RAP). They are currently short staffed.**
- **United States Forest Service: Matt Ahearn introduced himself. He discussed fuels treatment, recent lightning strikes, and other related topics.**
- **CHP: Sgt. Barajas invited everyone to the CHP open house on September 4th at the CHP office in Running Springs. He also discussed the recent closure of Hwy 38 due to a mudslide.**

- **San Bernardino County Sheriff:** Cpt. Lupear invited everyone to “National Night Out” on Thursday at the Twin Peaks Sheriff’s office. He discussed the homeless issue on the mountain and at the bottom of the hill. The HOPE Team has been working with homeless camps at the bottom of Hwy 18 and Hwy 330. Still partnering with the US Forest Service providing OHV patrols on USFS land. Cpt Lupear also shared 2021 crime statistics from the unincorporated areas of the County.
- **Crestline Lake Gregory Chamber of Commerce:** Sara Green discussed Corks and Hops, the Crestline Trolley, new website, and their events calendar.
- **Mountain Transit:** Kyle Schulty announced that Mountain Transit has selected Scott Rindenow to fill the vacancy on their board.
- **Rim of the World Unified School District:** Dana Ridland announced that school starts on August 11th. They have hired a new Superintendent as well as a new Director of Special Services. The District office is in escrow and they plan on moving the District Office to the Grandview School property.
- **Senator Ochoa-Bogh’s office:** Sidney Sonck gave an update on current legislation. He also discussed SB 1405, which is a proposal to transfer management of Arrowhead Woods Architectural Committee to the Lake Arrowhead Community Services District.

6.0 Supervisor’s Report: Lewis Murray discussed a new ordinance addressing catalytic converter thefts, hemp regulations, a new ballot measure submitted by the Board of Supervisors to address term limits and salary, and a ballot measure to recover the County’s “Fair Share” of tax dollars from the State and Federal government.

7.0 Correspondence & Announcements from Board Members: Rick Dinon shared that he has been in communication with the Crestline Post office regarding security and possible change in operating hours. Gil Flores shared an announcement regarding an upcoming Youth Football Clinic. Penny Schubnell shared some of the challenges they are facing with regards to lake guests using the parking area at the Senior Center.
